- Section 8. Absentee Voting Policy (Approved by the Nampa Association of REALTOR'S® Board of Directors):

*Absentee ballots will be made available two weeks prior to the General Membership Vote. To be deemed valid, ballots must contain the individuals' personal NRDS number and their signature. Absentee ballots must be hand delivered to the Nampa Association of REALTOR'S® Office by each voting member and must be received two days prior to the General Membership Vote.*

Article V. Section 5. Continuing Member Code of Ethics Training

Effective January 1, 2001, through December 31, 2004, and for successive two four year periods thereafter beginning with December 31, 2008, each REALTOR® member of the association (with the exception of REALTOR® members granted REALTOR® Emeritus status by the National Association) shall be required to complete biannual quadrennial ethics training of not less than two hours and thirty minutes of instructional time. This requirement will be satisfied upon presentation of documentation that the member has completed a course of instruction conducted by this or another association, the State Association of REALTORS®, the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS®, or any other recognized educational institution or provider which meets the learning objectives and minimum criteria established by the NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF REALTORS® from time to time. REALTOR® members who have completed training as a requirement of membership in another association and REALTOR® members who have completed the New Member Code of Ethics Orientation during any two-four year cycle shall not be required to complete additional ethics training until a new two year cycle commences.

Failure to satisfy this requirement shall be considered a violation of a membership duty for which REALTOR® membership shall be suspended until such time as the training is completed. (Adopted 1/01)

Failure to meet the requirement for the second (2005 through 2008) cycle and subsequent two (2) four (4) year cycles will result in suspension of membership for the first two months (January and February) of the year following the end of any two (2) four (4) year cycle or until the requirement is met, whichever occurs sooner. On March 1 of that year, the membership of a member who is still suspended as of that date will be automatically terminated. (adopted 1/01. Amended 5/05)
